From the Desk of Father Jarvis



Dear Parish Family,

The summer heat is upon us and the warmth of the sun brings about new life through its burning flames. The month of June brings us to thoughts of the purifying love of the Divine Heart of the Son of God, Jesus. His Sacred Heart is honored in this great month which has been the tradition for centuries starting with the revelations experienced by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 1670s. Jesus appeared to her and revealed to her the love that He has for all the children of God and did so specifically through the image of a Heart burning with the fire of purity, humility and meekness. Therefore this month is centered on humility, not pride. In fact, this burning Heart of love that Jesus has for us is not just a symbol, it is the core of fulfillment and flourishing for each of us. Ultimately, we are happy when we live as we ought to live: that is, according to our great dignity. The central orientation of that dignity is one of self sacrifice and love which gives of itself for the soul purpose of bringing forth life. We are not happy until we live self-gift and that requires a heart on fire with sacrifice. Reginald Garrigou-Lagrange said, "The best thing one can do with the best of things is sacrifice it." This points to our need to live a life of self-gift which offers up pains, ills, joys and sufferings and does so as a means of expiation and reparation for our own sins and the sins of the whole world. In this way we are able to enter into the heat of the love of the Heart of Jesus and with Him pour ourselves out to bring forth new life. This is lived out biologically in the married love of a man and a woman who bring forth life in a new child, but it can be seen supernaturally in the suffering united to the Heart of Jesus for the reparation of the sins of our brothers and sisters who do not know Christ or who do know Him yet reject Him.

We need not look any further for the example par excellence than the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, where Jesus offers Himself for the world with a Heart on fire with love and pierced so to be opened up and to bring forth new life; that is, new life in the Church through the sacraments.

We kick off this month of June with the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ, and thus celebrate the great humility of our Savior and His most Sacred Heart as we process through, with and in Him who is the Best and is Sacrificed for us by humbly taking on the accidents of bread in the form of a little host. This month let us offer our own comforts, self-will and worldly attachments to the burning love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus truly present and beating in the Holy Sacrament of the altar. "Jesus meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto Thine."

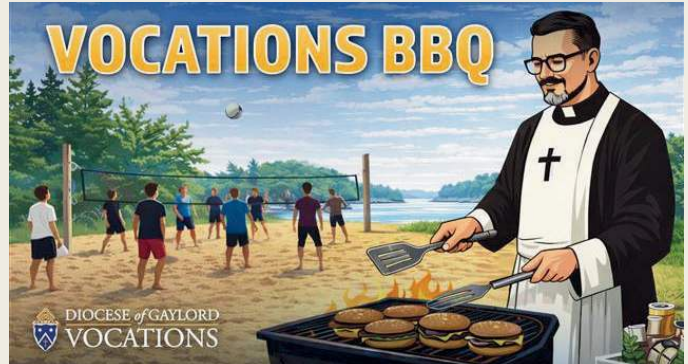


